ICON - Conference on Holy Land



Fr. Imad Twal (Jordan), member of the World Secretariat of ICCS, participated in a Conference of *ICON (International Catholic Organization Network)* as representative of ICCS on the 21st of November in New York/USA. The topic of this Conference were the political and social situation of the Holy Land (Palestine, Israel and Jordan) and the presence of the Christians, living there as "living stones" of the Church. The participants of the Conference discussed also ecumenical aspects and realities and looked after the impact of the "Arab spring" on the region. Finally the role of the Catholic Church for the development of the Middle East countries was a subject of discussion under the aspects of social commitment as well as of spiritual and moral education.

Key note speaker was Theodore Cardinal McCarrick, Archbishop emeritus of Washington D.C., with whom Father Imad Twal had an exchange of experiences and ideas.

Fellowship Saint Paul established

The World Council of ICCS in St. Louis 2011 has welcome the decision of founding the Fellowship Saint Paul as a new element in the system of provision of financial help for the work of ICCS. The Fellowship, an idea of the leaving Secretary General, Baldur Hermans, was presented by the members of the ICCS Foundation (ICFS) Toby Suzuki (Japan), Jerry Scanlan (USA) and Roger Richter (Luxembourg), treasurer of the Foundation.
